

How the Establishment Republicans do NOT want YOU to know the TRUTH about what is really happening with Our Elections

On April 28, 2026, I hand delivered a letter to the individual offices of every single Republican member of the North Carolina General Assembly – customized and addressed to each of these members. This letter details some of the examples of how the Establishment has tried to stop me in getting this most important message out to the people. (FYI, Jason Simmons is the statewide GOP Chairman; Dan Bishop is a former Congressman who was running for state Attorney General in the 2024 General Election; and Sam Hayes is the Executive Director of the NC State Board of Elections.) The following is the content of the letter given to the Republican members of the assembly:

While this message is customized and addressed specifically to you, this same message is being given to every Republican member of the North Carolina General Assembly. And I dedicate this message to the retired longtime member Rep. George Cleveland and to the recent passing member Rep. Mike Clampitt. Both of these members were (are) great American patriots, and both were big advocates and emotional supporters of my election integrity work.

I am the main individual behind www.ForFreeAndFairElections.com, with the occasional support of Dr. Stan Young – who is an adjunct professor of statistics at North Carolina State University. We have conducted groundbreaking research into analyzing our election results, following what happened in 2020. Mathematically, we have come up with new and innovative ways of looking at our elections – things that people have never thought of before. In the last couple of years, we have developed a one-of-a-kind time series analysis that shows the possible “unusualness” of an election cycle. And I have personally been able to figure out one of the greatest mysteries of our time – what actually and really happened in the 2020 election for states like North Carolina. It was NOT fraud in the customarily way that we think of; but rather, it was (is) the “time factor” allowing the Democrat Party, and even parts of our own government, to abuse Early Voting and the No-Excuse Absentee Ballot. For North Carolina, election law by the Legislature has constantly been changing over a number of decades. Because of these law changes, the North Carolina Legislature has given the Democrat Party an unfair advantage, and what you have now is different forms of “vote harvesting” taking place. Because when you change the way elections are conducted, you change the outcome! This is the reason why many Republican statewide victories over the past 2+ decades here in North Carolina have been razor thin, with shrinking margins – when the victories should have been HUGE. The details of exactly what has been happening to our elections can be found in the enclosed Voter-Info Newsletter. This is something that every citizen of North Carolina should become aware of!

I have worked for 5 years with little to no pay – no support from the Republicans or from the Legislature. You in the Legislature are always giving free grant money for good causes; yet you don’t give me a dime. I would think my job of trying to keep our system of voting honest to be one of the most important jobs imaginable. The Legislature compensates Major Dave (David Goetze) for his work involving election integrity. Is my work any less important and/or credible than his? And for this matter, is not the work of Carol Snow, Jim Womack, Dr. Stan Young, and John Droz, Jr. – all here in North Carolina also deserving of recognition and even compensation by the Legislature? People get all up in arms about the TSA employees going without a paycheck for a couple of weeks; you should see how it feels to go without one for five years. It devastates one’s finances! If it wasn’t for my brother providing a roof over my head and working at a part-time job 20 hours a week, I would not have been able to do this most important work that you are holding in your hands.

I can understand why the Democrats might not want this information to be made public, but I have actually had Republicans in the Establishment wing of the party to try to stop me and to stop me from bringing this information to the attention of the public and to our elected officials. One such individual who has tried to stand in my way to get this most important message out about our elections has been Jason Simmons. At a campaign event just outside of Clayton in October of 2024, I tried to briefly speak with Dan Bishop, who I had met once before in the town of Hillsborough. I wanted to give him a page of information printed on front and back (of which is mostly contained as one of the pages in the enclosed newsletter). After I was able to remind him that we had met once before, an aide immediately interrupted our conversation (I believe a put-up job by Mr. Simmons). Later when I tried to approach Mr. Bishop

again, a scene was made by Senator Tom McInnis of Cumberland and Moore Counties by yelling and screaming at me in public, ordering me to “Get Away!” With GOP Chair sitting at this same table as Mr. Bishop and Mr. McInnis, again I believe Mr. Simmons was the one behind and causing this most embarrassing moment – when all I was attempting to do was to briefly talk with one of our elected representatives running for public office at a social event and banquet.

I have reached out to Sam Hayes on several occasions, only to be ignored. In his public statements, he touts Early Voting and the No-Excuse Absentee Ballots as being something “great and wonderful.” I wonder if Mr. Hayes is a Republican, or might he really be a Democrat?

Once Dave Boliek became the new State Auditor, I tried to reach out to him as well. When I went to his office to try to set an appointment, I was only allowed to speak with one of his assistants. After explaining that I have been talking with a number of members over at the Legislature about my work, this assistant actually tried to question me as to what business did I have to be speaking with the members of the Legislature. Imagine the audacity of this person, when referring to a citizenry legislature! Well, I never got a meeting with Mr. Boliek at his office; and later, my email address was even blocked by his office. I was, however, able to briefly meet Mr. Boliek recently at the Wake County GOP Convention on March 24th. I was finally able to personally hand him a copy of the enclosed Voter-Info Newsletter. While it has my email address printed on it, I have not heard back yet from Mr. Boliek about how the abuse of Early Voting and the No-Excuse Absentee Ballot are altering our elections.

I should be considered the best friend that the Republicans could ever have with the work I’m doing, but look how I have been treated! (And I have more stories of this abusive treatment.)

As mentioned, I am giving this to every Republican member of the North Carolina General Assembly. Maybe a few of you will do the right thing and see to it that this matter is investigated, and how changing election law is actually changing the outcomes to elections.

Dear Mr. Simmons,

I must have really stumbled across a deep dark secret that the Republican Party has been holding. I believe you all have known all along that there is a major problem with Early Voting and the No-Excuse Absentee Ballot – that our elections results are being manipulated and altered by these two factors. How dare I come along to discover this and actually put some potential numbers to the problem. I believe this might be the reason why I have been treated the way I have by the likes of you, Dave Boliek, Sam Hayes, and others – the Establishment Republicans. (I also wonder how Major Dave – David Goetze comes into this equation? He might be the common denominator.) You the Establishment fear two things. One is if the public finds out the TRUTH to the actual extent of the problem. And you fear that if the Republican Party tries to do anything such as introducing legislation to roll back Early Voting and No-

Excuse Absentee Ballot (with what has seemingly become very popular with the public), then there will likely be such a backlash that it does much more harm than good for the party. I, however, believe in a different approach. I believe in first being truthful and telling the people what is actually happening to our elections; and then, letting the people decide how they want to approach and deal with the matter.

It has taken me five years to put all the pieces together, but I have finally figured out what really happened in 2020 – for states like North Carolina. And I have the numbers to prove it! It has been a real learning experience. Sure, I have made mistakes along the way and have even come to some wrong conclusions regarding my work early on; but seeking the truth has always been my objective. Immediately following the 2020 election, there was a great deal of uncertainty by nearly everyone, and there were a good number of Republicans who thought the election was “stolen” and the problem was “fraud.” I started out myself as believing that too. But I wanted to know the TRUTH and to find out what really happened. If it was fraud, then let’s uncover the evidence; and if it was something else, then let’s get to the bottom of that as well. The 2022 Midterms represented a mind shift in my thinking. I did a lot of observing of the polls at the Early Voting sites to the lead up of the general election in November of that year, and this caused a change in how I saw things. Because of who I saw with my own eyes showing up to the polls to vote, I started to consider the possibility that what happened in 2020 might not have been completely the result of election fraud – I could tell that over 50% of the people here in Wake County voting were actually Democrats (and it was actually real easy in how I could tell).

If you remember, I met with you, when you were the Executive Director, during the middle of 2022, and I did a presentation involving a “big board” that I was promoting which contained all types of statistical facts and figures. At that point in time, I was pretty convinced that what happened in 2020 was the result of election fraud. With me being new to this stuff, you corrected me in pointing out that statistics alone does not prove fraud. You also said something else that was rather interesting. You said, “What happened in 2020 was NOT because of fraud. It was because of ‘polarization.’” I left that discussion with you that day and went back to reevaluate my data – based upon your comments. Then about a week before the Midterms in November, I was riding around Cameron Village and decided to drop by the GOP to ask for a follow-up discussion with you. On that particular day, you were manning the front door to the headquarters on Hillsborough Street. When you saw me walk in, you immediately pointed to the front door and YELLED at me to “Get Out!” – When all I had done was to simply walk in the front door of the GOP headquarters. I wonder; is this how you treat everybody when you are having a bad day, or is it just with me? I believe, this might have been the last time either one of us have spoken to one another. And then there was that incident outside of Clayton in 2024 at the Sportsman Banquet where you orchestrated the embarrassing scene against me using Senator Tom McInnis.

You in the Establishment wing of the party like to ridicule anyone of us who might question the integrity of our elections, especially that of 2020. You label us as the “crazies” and “disseminators of false information.” Although, I find the work of Carol Snow, Jim Womack, Dr. Stan Young, and John Droz, Jr. to be truthful and very credible. As for my work, I put all the numbers out there for the public to scrutinize and examine. I challenge anyone to be specific in showing where I am wrong in with my work, especially with the current work involving our time series analysis.

My thoughts about our elections have been an evolving one since starting back in 2020. Anyone can make a mistake and occasionally be in error – that’s just part of being human. But armed with more knowledge and insight now, I still believe there is fraud in our elections; but at lower levels than what I first believed. As to what the level of fraud is, I don’t know for certain; and I don’t believe anyone else knows the exact level either – because of all the unknowns involved. There are two things that one needs to look at involving election integrity. One is the traditional things that we typically think of as election fraud; and then there is the abuse of Early Voting and No-Excuse Absentee Ballot – which I believe is where the really big numbers come into existence. Now if this is an “extreme” position to hold or if I am “crazy” to believe this, then I would like to know where I am wrong. Otherwise, I believe you might owe me an apology in the way you have treated me.
